

INFORMATION FOR THE TUNL TOUR - TUNL = Triangle Universities Nuclear Laboratory
FRIDAY AFTERNOON TOUR – MEET AT THE TUNL LOBBY BY 3:15 PM (Plan for 3 pm.)

The TUNL facility is a white concrete, square building located off of Science Drive behind the Physics and Math building. It is positioned between the Physics and Math Building, the FEL Building, the parking lot next to the French Family Research Center Building and the LSRC buildings. Since it is a nuclear facility, the TUNL building may not be marked on the map.

View of the TUNL building (highlighting the bike rack) seen as you walk down the hill from Science Drive off of the traffic circle on the north side of the Physics and Math Building. (The Math and Physics Bldg. should be on your left as you walk down the driveway.) The entrance to the lobby is around the building in this view on the left side.

If you are walking from the Duke Chapel, walk around the chapel toward the Bryan Center and continue toward Science Drive. Facing the chapel, walk around the left side of the chapel and walk down the stairs toward the Bryan Center, then continue walking with the Bryan Center on your left side. (You can ask the bus driver to point you in the direction to walk toward the Bryan Center.) After you pass the parking area, you will take the path that will angle to the right leaving you on Science Drive facing the Physics and Math Building. Walk toward the top of the traffic circle to the gated driveway on the right side of the Math and Physics building. Walk down the hill toward the parking lot and you will see the TUNL building as above. Walk to the left side of the building toward the parking area at the bottom of the hill and the entrance is on your right side.

If you drive on Friday afternoon, please park in the Bryan Center parking area. The cost is \$2 per hour. In the garage, I believe that you will be charged \$2 for any fraction of an hour, and in the pay lot near the garage, you can pay say \$3 for 1.5 hours using the pay stations. If you are driving from the hotel to West Campus, take Main Street and turn right onto 9th street which will become Erwin road after you pass under the railroad tracks. Turn left onto Towerview Drive (called Moreene Rd. to the right), continue through a 4-way stop and turn left onto Science Drive at the light. Just before the traffic circle, the Bryan Center parking area will be on your right.

From the Bryan Center parking area, walk toward Science Drive by walking with the parking area on your left. The Math and Physics building will be in front of you. Turn right to walk down the driveway hill on the right side of the building as above.
